

## Building Our Future

### Benefits of our Renovation

- Create an environment that is beautiful, hospitable and inviting, and that fully engages all parishioners in the joyful worship of God
- Locate our Baptismal pool/font at the entrance to our church to allow for the baptism of infants and full immersion of adults, and to remind us of our baptismal call
- Include a large crucifix and a worthy tabernacle in the sanctuary
- Design a Blessed Sacrament Chapel to give proper attention to the reserved Eucharist and to create a space for private devotion
- Install curved pews to facilitate a clear view of the sacred actions of the liturgy for all in the church, and to enhance our participation in unity and community as we worship together
- Create an improved exterior for our church building that clearly identifies Holy Trinity as a place of worship and a house of God
- Add a narthex, a main entry of gathering where the community greets one another as we enter into worship, and that will provide a space for parents with children in distress, and serve as overflow seating when needed
- Install a soundproof wall between the church and social hall
- Add a drive-up covered canopy at the main entrance to the church to protect people from the elements
- Include ramps to the altar platform to assist parishioners with physical disabilities
- Create a dedicated music ministry area
- Install modern sound technology and electronic visual displays to hear and see the liturgy more clearly
- Add skylights and install new light fixtures to improve visibility in the church
- Modernize and brighten the floors, walls, ceiling and exposed wood
