



Do you know that our parish donates over \$50,000 a year to support our brothers and sisters in need?

- ✚ About half of this amount is collected at 10 different times throughout the year via specially marked envelopes and on-line donations. These special collections support Catholic Community Services, Catholic Missions, Catholic Relief Services, the Lenten Rice Bowls, etc.
- ✚ The other half is collected via the “Charity Fund.” These funds come from any money or checks placed in the **pink “Holy Trinity Charity Fund” envelopes** found in the pews, or semi-annually in your envelope packets that are mailed to your home. Additionally, any loose coins (**NOT bills**) that are put in the collection baskets are also added to our Charity Fund.
- ✚ Money from our Charity Fund provides monthly monetary support to 12 different Non-Profit Organizations (NPOs) here in Kitsap County. These NPOs are: YWCA Alive Program, St. Vincent de Paul Society, Pregnancy Resource Center, Kitsap Rescue Mission, Bremerton Foodline, Central Kitsap Foodbank, CK Backpacks 4 Kids food program, Stand Up for Kids, Kitsap Community Resources/WIC, Kitsap Immigration Assistance Center, Coffee Oasis, and The Lord’s Neighborhood Diner.
- ✚ Additionally, we provide monthly support to 3 additional NPOs outside our county, to include the support of a seminarian in the Philippines.

We are ONLY able to support these worthwhile organizations in their mission to serve our brothers and sisters through YOUR generous support to our Charity Fund.

-However, in recent months we have seen a decrease in donations to this fund and without increased support, we may need to reduce the support that we provide to them.
